LEGISLATION

Over the past two legislative seasons in Georgia, two Pro-Life bills were passed, The Woman’s Right to Know bill and also the Sonogram bill. Many who have participated in 40 Days for Life were horrified to discover that these laws are not enforced. ProLifeUnity is working to erase the gulf that exists between lawmakers and law enforcement. Praise God that there are a number of legislators eager to work to improve law enforcement within the city of Atlanta especially in regards to the abortion industry. We need helpers and volunteers in this area.

Currently HR 536 rests in the House Judiciary committee. This committee has a Planned Parenthood endorsed Republican chairman- Wendell Willard. The Speaker of the House, Glenn Richardson, assigns bills to committee and can reassign the bills. Call Glenn or email, and ask him to reassign the bill to insure it will make it to the House Floor for the vote.

Each day at the mills when sidewalk counselors and prayer warriors gather, babies are saved. Sometimes women who choose life for their babies remain in contact with the counselors, or at least give us their name, but most of the time they remain anonymous.

Gloria Syms chose life for her baby at Atlanta Surgi-Center a couple months ago. Jenny is in regular contact with the family. There are 8 children in the household, and they do have some very specific needs. There is a need list on the back of the newsletter. Please be in prayer for Gloria and her family, and also contact Jenny if you can help with their physical needs.

Alfredo and Patricia changed their mind about abortion at Governor's Ridge. Patricia was in need of treatment for her gallbladder, and the doctor refused to treat her until she aborted her baby. Praise God that Margarita and Jenny were in the parking lot. Margarita took the parents to Kennestone, where they were referred to another doctor. Patricia was treated and mother and baby are doing fine. They have a 2 year old daughter.

Haley is a 14 year old mother who was brought to Atlanta Surgi-Center for an abortion by her mother. The family decided to keep the baby. We no longer have contact with them, but please continue to pray for Haley and her pregnancy, and her growth in the Lord.
